EXPLORER GUIDE SHEET

Eye Spy Bottle

Materials:

A clear bottle with a wide opening and a secure lid
Glitter

Waterproof objects
Water

Directions:

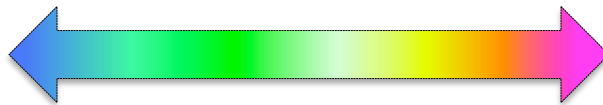
1. Place your waterproof objects and glitter inside your bottle
2. Fill your bottle with water
3. Seal your bottle so the water cannot get out
4. Use your eyes to explore - see if you can find all the objects!

Helpful Hints:

- Adding waterbeads to your bottle can create a cool effect!
- Make a visual guide by taking pictures of all your objects before you put them in the bottle. This will help you keep track of the objects you can find
- Vary the size, shape, and theme of the objects
- Use a bottle that you can re-open - this way you can switch up the objects every so often.
